



## Saddleworth Netball Club – Code of Conduct - Residential

As a member of the squad at a residential tournament I fully understand and agree to the following conditions:

- Behaviour at tournaments is the same as expected at training; everyone should behave in a respectful manner; both towards the volunteer parents, coaches and team managers.
- At no time are you allowed to leave either the tournament venue or the accommodation without permission from a Club Coach. And you will only be allowed to leave if you are with a responsible adult.
- You should always make your Team Manager/Coach aware of your whereabouts at all times.
- Please do not put any photo's or video's onto any social media sites which may be upsetting or cause any embarrassment to anyone.
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- Anyone behaving in a disruptive manner will be warned but if this continues your parent's / guardians will be contacted and asked to collect you from the tournament.
- As a member of the team I will work hard and try my best to make the team as successful as possible. I will support and respect my other team members at all times and not use any negative or intimidating language or behaviour towards them.
- I am fully aware and accept that if selected to play I may have to play in different positions and may have less game time than other team members.
- I will at all times respect any decisions made by the coach or team manager. I will at all times respect any decisions made by officials and show respect towards them.
- Please ensure you are dressed at tournaments in the correct club match kit – Saddleworth club dress, Saddleworth hoodie, Saddleworth socks or plain white socks and appropriate trainers. Fingernails must be cut to the appropriate length and all jewellery removed. Hair must be tied back.
- All personal equipment must be taken care of at all times as the club cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to personal possessions.
- Club Coaches and Team Managers must be made aware of any specific dietary requirements or medical conditions ahead of a residential tournament. Any medication which is being taken MUST be brought to the tournament.
- Parents MUST be contactable during residential tournaments in the event of an emergency. Team Managers MUST be provided with an up to date emergency contact number.
